Survey of Residents in the South Hero Village Zoning District In 2020 the Town of South Hero made the following zoning changes to the properties in your neighborhood...

- 1. The previous minimum lot size of 1 acre (or 0.75 acre if your property was zoned "shoreland") was eliminated, i.e., there now is NO minimum lot size.
- 2. The property line setback for principal and accessory dwellings was reduced from 25 feet to 10 feet.
- 3. The property line setback for accessory structures was reduced from 15 feet to 5 feet.
- 4. The maximum building height was increased from 35 feet to 40 feet.
- 5. The previous minimum percentage green space of 30% on any lot was eliminated.

In summary, before 2020 the properties in your neighborhood were in either "rural/residential" or "shoreland" zoning districts. But in 2020 your properties were placed in a new zoning district called "village zoning."
